

Ice Cup 2014 - rules

1. System of Play

Teams are drawn into 3 groups (8 in Pink, 6 in Green, 6 in Red).

Two rounds will be played within the original groups on Thursday. Then all teams will be ranked together before pairing teams for the third round. All teams then play one game on Friday afternoon. After Third round and ranking of teams, they will be split into Event A (6 teams), B (6 teams) and C (8 teams). One more game within those groups on Saturday morning.

Teams are ranked according to points, then ends, then stones. Each game will be between teams ranked next to each other, as much as possible.

Medal games on Saturday afternoon:

1-2 in group A play for the gold medal

3-4 in group A play for bronze.

1-2 in group B play for B-Event winners.

1-2 in group C play for C-Event winners.

2. Games

Games are 7 ends. Ties are allowed. A win is 2 points, a tie is 1 point. Teams must play all 7 ends, unless both teams agree to stop playing. Keep in mind that ranking of teams could be decided by won ends or scored stones.

All medal games are 8 ends.

Otherwise, the games are played according to WCF rules and etiquettes.
