
Game rules

We play by the rules of WCF.

Teams are divided into three groups in the beginning and play 2 games. There after all teams are arranged by points before being paired for the 3rd game.

Rankings are made by points, ends, and rocks scored. Games are paired between teams that are closest to each other in ranking. Order may be rearranged to prevent rematches between teams.

Each game is 6 rounds. Draws are allowed. Winning gives two points, a draw gives one point. All rounds must be finished except both teams agree to stopping the game. Mind that ends and rocks count in ranking. Final games are 8 ends. Ranking: Teams are ranked according to points, then ends, then stones. If that criteria is not sufficient to decide which team play for medals, there will be a „draw to the button“ contest, sweeping allowed. Two members of the team deliver a stone to the button and the distance measured and the team with the less total distance is ranked higher
